Competition Overview

An invitation to all HKU students to design the next generation of **HKU Chemistry Souvenir**. Winning designs will be professionally printed on department folders and lab notebooks used across undergraduate and postgraduate programmes, and outreach activities.

Design Requirements

- "HKU Chemistry" Or "The University of Hong Kong Department of Chemistry"
- Designs should reflect **HKU Chemistry's identity** – excellence, innovation, and our unique position as a leading Asian chemistry department!

Competition Categories

1. Folder Design (A4 size)
2. Notebook Cover (A5 size)

The following groups will be judged and evaluated separately:

- a. HKU Student (AI-Assisted)
- b. HKU Student (Non-AI)
- c. High School Student (AI-Assisted)
- d. High School Student (Non-AI)

Submission Requirements

1. Design Digital files: .ai, .png or .pdf with 300 dpi or above
2. Brief design statement (150 words in English or Chinese)
3. Application Form
4. Copy of HKU Student ID card or valid Hong Kong Secondary School Student ID card or student handbook
5. Submission deadline: 28 Feb, 2026 (before 12:00 noon) to chemmail@hku.hk with the subject headline: HKU Chem Design Competition

Judging Criteria

- Creativity and originality (20%)
- Visual appeal and composition (20%)

- Relevance to chemistry themes (25%)
- Scientific correctness (10%)
- Practicality for printing/use (25%)

Winner for each category receives:

- **HK\$1,000** Cash Prize
- **Certificate** issued by the Department of Chemistry, The University of Hong Kong.

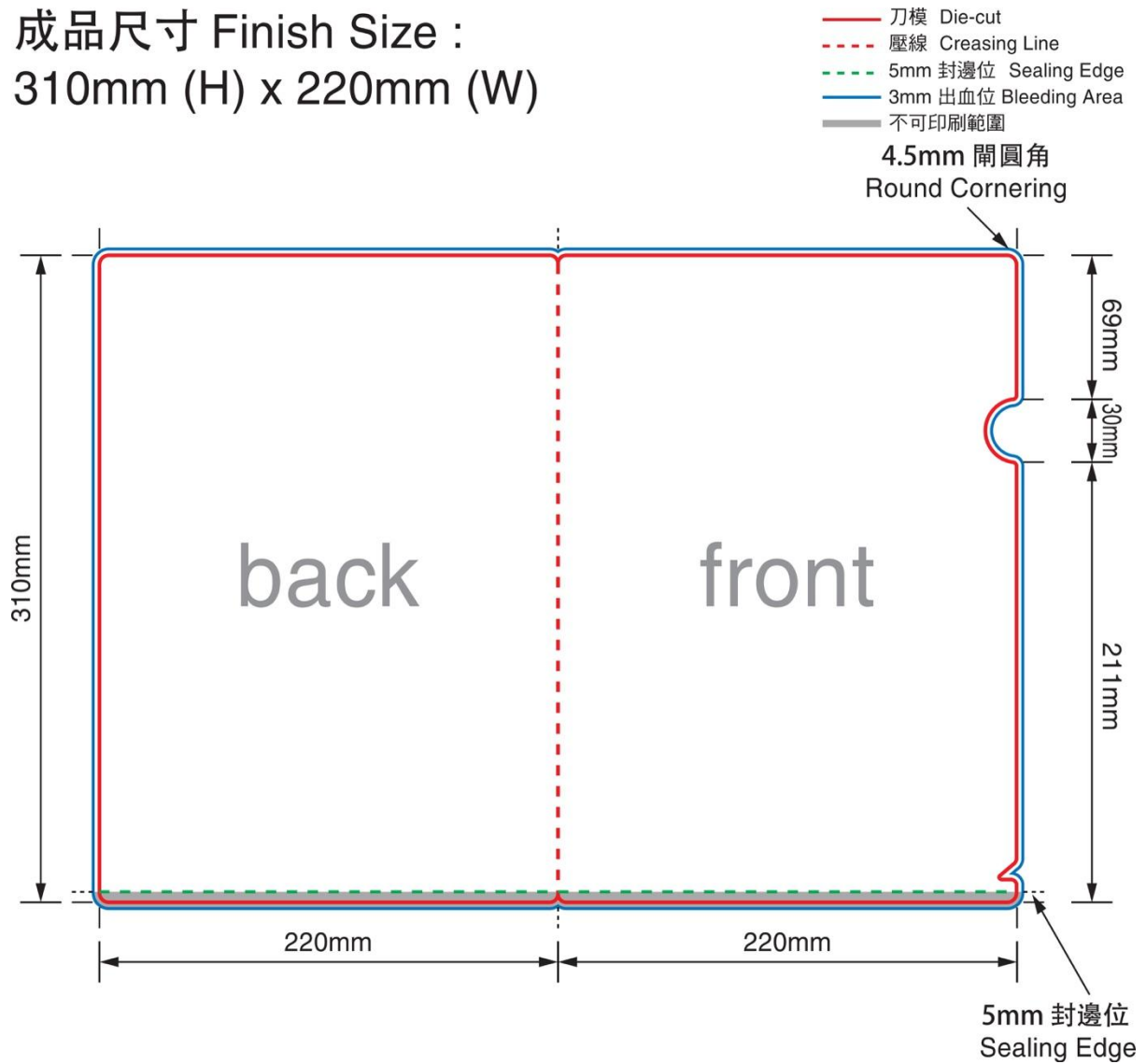

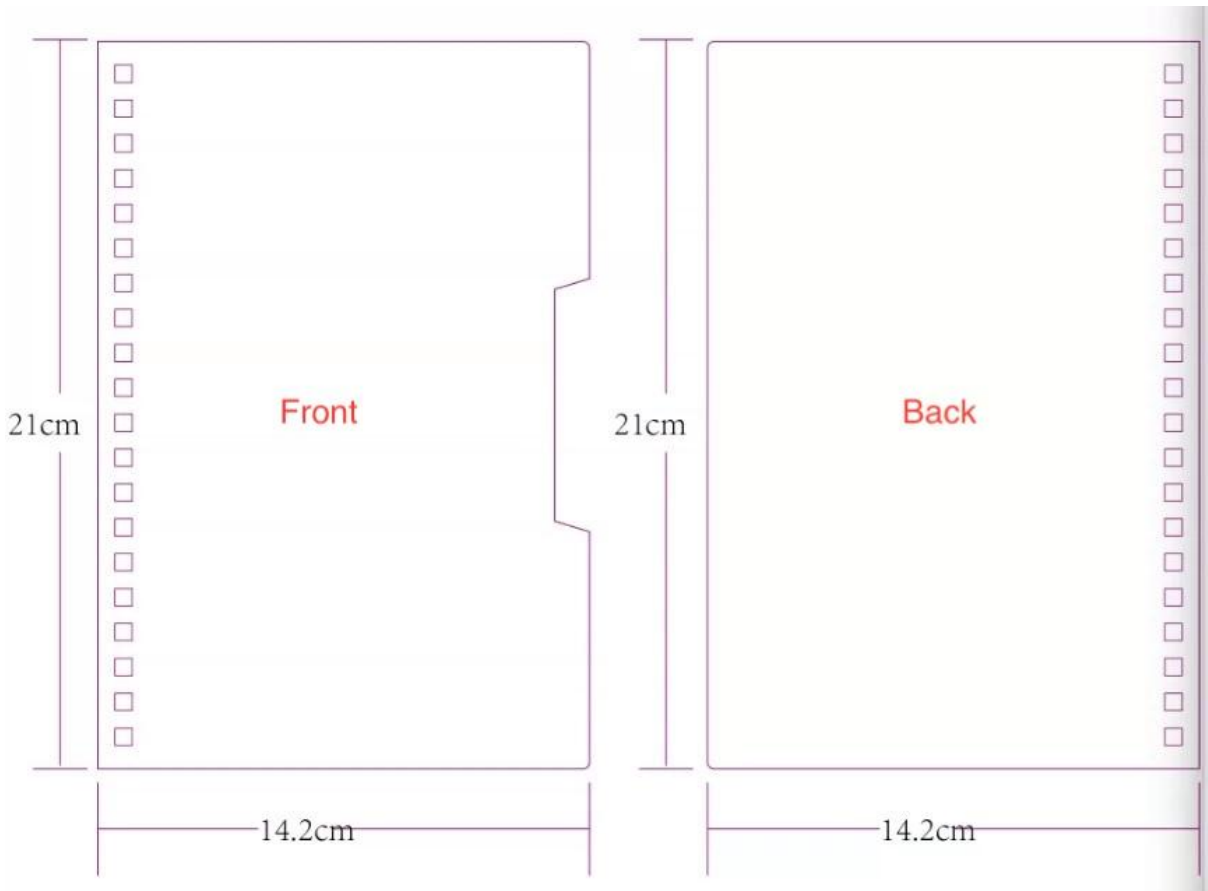
