Dear Year 2 Chemistry Students,

For students who intend to follow the **Intensive Chemistry-Major Curriculum (144 credits)**, please note that CHEM2541 Introductory physical chemistry is offered in Semester 2 only, but not in every semester. **If you want to do Intensive Chemistry-Major Curriculum, you should take CHEM2541 in S2 of your year 2 studies** so that you will have sufficient time to finish other core courses which require CHEM2541 as a pre-requisite (e.g. CHEM3541 and CHEM3542) by the end of your year 4 studies. **Also, it is a good idea to start taking some Level-3 CHEM core course(s) in Year 2 S1 if possible.**
